HOW GREEN CAMPUS PROGRAM WORKS



AWARENESS

This unique and copyrighted program amalgamates various learning methodologies with a Project-based and Cooperative Learning Approach.

After an educational institution registers, we start with a workshop for teachers to make them aware about climate change, provide them with teaching resources and offer them an online course. This boosts the teachers' confidence to take the issue of climate change to their classes and talk about the science, impacts, and solutions.

TEACHERS TRAINING WORKSHOP

It is a half-day workshop on climate change, based on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), and the six thematic areas of green campus.

ONLINE PROGRAMS

Teachers are provided with Online Teaching Resources like Posters, Infographics, Comics, Workbooks, and Booklets.

EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES

Teachers are offered a free Online Certification course on climate change to learn more about the issue and in-hand solutions.

ACTION

Through GCP, we enable schools and colleges to conserve natural resources like water and biodiversity; optimize energy efficiency; manage waste; and educate about climate change and sustainability, while addressing the well-being of the students as compared to conventional educational institutes.

ACCOLADES

Based on the initiatives undertaken by the registered educational institutions (to provide students with a healthy environment while gearing them up for a sustainable future), the evaluation is done for each institution. The certification recognizes the impacts of ideas and practices, followed by which, The Climate Project Foundation would recognize the campus as Green and award the institution with a certificate and trophy. Based on the results, a rating is provided for each Green Campus certified school.
